Hon. George Makari: Thank you Honorable Speaker, I am holding brief for Hon. Sospeter, but before I do, I want to sympathize with my friend Hon. Opwora, maybe we forgive him because he has a broken hand and may be it went into his head.

So Honorable Speaker as I proceed, I am holding brief for Hon. Sospeter Nyongesa, MCA West Bukusu, and the subject matter is a statement that says Community Empowerment Fund projects (CEF) in West Bukusu Ward and this statement is directed to the Chairperson of Finance and it says; pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order number 41(2) (c) of the Bungoma County Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby seek for a statement from the Chairperson, sectoral Committee on Finance and Economic Planning. This is in relation to the opaque information concerning the implementation of the CEF projects in West Bukusu Ward from the time the current regime of the County Government of Bungoma took over in 2017 to date. It also says in the response let the chair inquire into and report on the following:

1. The projects that are so far complete, ongoing and stalled under the CEF in the said ward
2. What the department is doing to have the earmarked projects that are incomplete or stalled completed?
3. The amount so far spent on each project and the balances if any?
