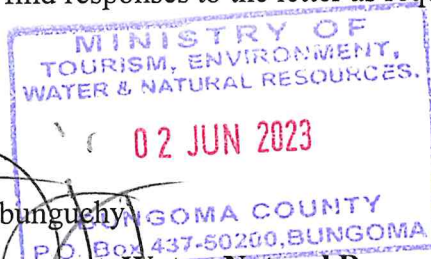

IMPLEMENTATION STATUS OF A MOTION ON DECENTRALIZATION OF DUMPSITES TO EVERY SUBCOUNTY

1. The department has not been able to implement the said resolutions due to lack of funding in the subsequent budgets FY 2021/22 and 2022/23.
2. As per the departments long term planning framework, it is envisioned that one of the key development priorities is provision of integrated solid waste management services whose key strategies are among others: (1) purchase of land for dumpsites (2) development of dumpsites. 4. The proposed locations earmarked for dumpsite development are within the Kimilili municipality, Webuye town, Tongaren, Chwele and Kapsokwony as per Departments workplans
5. The current budget (FY 2022/23) allocation for Fencing of Muanda Dumpsite is Kshs. 12,850,705 where the works are ongoing.
