BOX 2358-50200 BUNGOMA whose registered office is situated and located at Bungoma- (hereinafter called "the Contractor") on the other part; WHEREAS THE Client/Procuring entity/Employer is desirous that the Contractor ERECTION AND COMPLETION OF MATERNITY WING executes KAPTALELIO DISPENSARY as set out in Tender Negotiation No. 78684¶-3-2019/2020 (hereinafter referred to as "the Works") KAPTAMA and the Employer has accepted the tender submitted by the Contractor for the execution and completion of the Works and the remedying of defects therein, The contractor is willing and has accepted to execute the Works respectively as per the details set out in Tender negotiation No. 7 6849-3-2019-2020

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH as follows;

 In this Agreement, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract hereinafter referred to.

2. <u>Documents Constituting the Contract</u>

The following documents shall be deemed to form and shall be read und construct as part of this Agreement, namely;

- (ii) Instructions to tenderers.
- (iii) The General Conditions of Contract.
- (iv) The Special Conditions of Contract.

- (x) Priced Bills of Quantities/Priced Schedule of Rates.

- (xii) Tender Form and Price Schedules submitted by the bidder.

- (xv) The Confidential Business Questionnaire.

Where the provisions of any of the documents listed above are in conflict with the provisions of this Agreement, the latter shall prevail.

3. Execution and Works Completion

In consideration of the payments to be made by the Employer to the Contractor as hereinafter mentioned, the Contractor hereby covenants with the Employer to execute and complete the Works and remedy any defects therein in conformity with all respects with the provisions of the Contract.

4. Work's

The contractor shall construct and install the works in accordance with the specifications and drawings. The works may commence on the start date and shall be carried out in accordance with the program submitted by the contractor, as updated with the approval of the Project manager, and complete them by the intended completion date. The works to be executed under this Contract Agreement for ERECTION AND COMPLETION OF MATERNITY WING AT KAPTALELIO DISPENSARY shall comprise mainly but are not limited to the Demolitions, Substructures, Excavations, Disposal of water, Planking and strutting, Filling, Concrete work, Reinforcement, Sawn formwork to insitu concrete, Walling, Damp proof membranes, Plinth Finishes, Paving slabs, Collection, Reinforced concrete frame, Formwork to insitu concrete, Stairs and balustrade, Balustrades, Roofing, Carpentry, Boarding, Rainwater Installations, Painting and Decoration, Doors and Windows, Metal work, Ironmongery,

Finishes, Fittings and Fixtures, Painting, External Fencing, Civil Works, Associated Mechanical and Electrical installations, K.P.L service line and any other activity not listed above but may be deemed necessary and instructed by the Project Engineer as set out in Tender Negotiation No. 786849-3-2019/1020

5. Works Performance Standards

- a) The Contractor and the Employer in the Contractor in consideration of the execution and completion of the Works and the remedying of defects therein as described in the documents enlisted in clause 4 above shall establish an instrument to be signed by their respective representatives for each installation site.
- b) The Contractor undertakes to execute high quality works and to perform the works to the highest standards required of such a task.
- c) The Contractor undertakes and guarantees to provide the contacted Works as per the specifications set out in the Tender Document and shall meet the general deliverables detailed therein. The employer's Project Of daily basis and on such other periodic intervals verify that the said deliverables are met and prepare an appropriate recommendations which together with a monthly summary of the works standard attained, shall accompany the invoices for payment.

6. Warranty

a) The Contractor warrants that it has the appropriate licenses and a uthorizations required to ERECTION AND COMPLETION OF MATERNIT (WING AT KAPTALELIO DISPENSARY as set out in Tender Negotiation 2019-2020 located in KAPTAMA in Bungoma County and to upgrading and carry out any relevant works hereto and shall at all times during the currency of this Agreement continue to have the said authorizations.

- b) The Contractor further warrants that the Materials supplied are free from any manufacturer's defect and grant a warranty for a period of 12 months starting from the date of the relevant Site Acceptance Test Certificate. For any item for which a manufacturer's warranty is granted, such warranty will be transferred "as is" in lieu of any other warranty.
- free of charge within a reasonable time from the date the Contractor is notified in writing of such failure by the Employer or from the date the failed material is sent for repair, provided that they have been used and maintained in accordance with the related Instructions Manuals and have not been subject to unauthorized repair or alterations.
- d) The original period of warranty, of the repaired equipment under warranty, will be extended for a period equivalent to the time required for said repair. If the equipment is replaced, the original warranty period will be applied for the replaced equipment.
- e) The Contractor shall not be liable for any event not attributable to The Contractor's fault, or from bad handling or storage, improper use, change or repair done by the Employer or any third party.

7. Confidentiality

The Contractor, its staff and employees acknowledges that in dealing with the Employer pursuant to this Agreement it may come across information, which is confidential and proprietary to the Employer, disclosure or use of which might result in damage or loss to the business or affairs of the Employer. It is therefore agreed that the Contractor shall keep all such information Private and confidential, emphasize the same on its employees and staff and may only disclose the same without the prior written consent of the Employer or unless ordered to do so by an order of a Court of competent jurisdiction or is required by law to do so or unless such information is already in the public domain. For the avoidance of

doubt it is agreed that the provisions of this clause shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

8. Payments







Contract Agreement

WHEREAS THE Client/Procuring entity/Employer is desirous that the Contrac executes CONSTRUCTION OF KABULA MARKET MORDEN TOILETS KABULA WARD BUNGOMA COUNTY as set out in Tender Negotiation No. 7887/2 2019/2020 (hereinafter referred to as "the Works") KABULA WARD and the Employ has accepted the tender submitted by the Contractor for the execution and completic of the Works and the remedying of defects therein, The contractor is willing and haccepted to execute the Works respectively as per the details set out in Tenden negotiation No. 788783-2019/2020

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH as follows;

1. In this Agreement, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as at respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract hereinafter referred to.

2. <u>Documents Constituting the Contract</u>

The following documents shall be deemed to form and shall be read and construed as part of this Agreement, namely;

- (i) Invitation to Tender/tender notice.
- (ii) Instructions to tenderers.
- (iii) The General Conditions of Contract.
- (iv) The Special Conditions of Contract.
- (v) Appendix to Conditions of Contract.
- (vi) The procuring entity's letter of notification of tender award.
- (vii) Letter of Acceptance by the Tenderer/contractor.

- (viii) The Form of Tender.
- (Ix) Technical Specifications and Drawings.
- (x) Priced Bills of Quantities/Priced Schedule of Rates.
- (xi) Schedule of requirements.
- (xii) Tender Form and Price Schedules submitted by the bidder.
- (xiii) Tender Security Form.
- (xiv) Performance Security Form.
- (xv) The Confidential Business Questionnaire.

Where the provisions of any of the documents listed above are in conflict with the provisions of this Agreement, the latter shall prevail.

Execution and Works Completion

In consideration of the payments to be made by the Employer to the Contractor as hereinafter mentioned, the Contractor hereby covenants with the Employer to execute and complete the Works and remedy any defects therein in conformity with all respects with the provisions of the Contract.

4. Work's

The contractor shall construct and install the works in accordance with the specifications and drawings. The works may commence on the start date and shall be carried out in accordance with the program submitted by the contractor, as updated with the approval of the Project manager, and complete them by the intended completion date. The works to be executed under this Contract Agreement for CONSTRUCTION OF KABULA MARKET MORDEN TOILETSIN KABULA WARD shall comprise mainly but are not limited to the Demolitions, Substructures, Excavations, Disposal of water, Planking and strutting, Filling, Concrete work, Reinforcement, Sawn formwork to insitu concrete, Walling, Damp proof membranes, Plinth Finishes, Paving slabs, Collection, Reinforced concrete frame, Formwork to insitu concrete, Stairs and balustrade, Balustrades, Roofing, Carpentry, Boarding, Rainwater Installations, Painting and Decoration, Doors and Windows, Metal work, Ironmongery,

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Finishes, Fittings and Fixtures, Painting, External Fencing, Civil Works, Associated Mechanical and Electrical installations, K.P.L service line and any other activity not listed above but may be deemed necessary and instructed by the Project Engineer as set out in Tender Negotiation No. 788783-2019/2020

5. Works Performance Standards

- a) The Contractor and the Employer in the Contractor in consideration of the execution and completion of the Works and the remedying of defects therein as described in the documents enlisted in clause 4 above shall establish an instrument to be signed by their respective representatives for evaluation at each installation site.
- b) The Contractor undertakes to execute high quality works and to perform the works to the highest standards required of such a task.
- c) The Contractor undertakes and guarantees to provide the contracted Works as per the specifications set out in the Tender Document and shall meet the general deliverables detailed therein. The employer's Project Officers shall on daily basis and on such other periodic intervals verify that the said deliverables are met and prepare an appropriate report with recommendations which together with a monthly summary of the works standard attained, shall accompany the invoices for payment.

6. Warranty

a) The Contractor warrants that it has the appropriate licenses and authorizations required to CONSTRUCTION OF KABULA MARKET MORDEN TOILETS IN KABULA WARD as set out in Tender Negotiation No.788783-2019/2020 located in KABULA in Bungoma County and to undertake the construction and carry out any relevant works hereto and shall at all times during the currency of this Agreement continue to have the said licenses and authorizations.

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ns S O I The Contractor further warrants that the Materials supplied are free from any manufacturer's defect and grant a warranty for a period of 12 months starting from the date of the relevant Site Acceptance Test Certificate. For any item for which a manufacturer's warranty is granted, such warranty will be transferred "as is" in lieu of any other warranty.

- During the warranty period the defective materials will be repaired or replaced tree of charge within a reasonable time from the date the Contractor is notified in writing of such failure by the Employer or from the date the failed material is sont for repair, provided that they have been used and maintained in accordance with the related Instructions Manuals and have not been subject to unauthorized repair or alterations.
- (I) The original period of warranty, of the repaired equipment under warranty, will be extended for a period equivalent to the time required for said repair. If the equipment is replaced, the original warranty period will be applied for the replaced equipment.
- The Contractor shall not be liable for any event not attributable to The Contractor's fault, or from bad handling or storage, improper use, change or repair done by the Employer or any third party.

Confidentiality

The Contractor, its staff and employees acknowledges that in dealing with the Employer pursuant to this Agreement it may come across information, which is confidential and proprietary to the Employer, disclosure or use of which might result in damage or loss to the business or affairs of the Employer. It is therefore agreed that the Contractor shall keep all such information Private and confidential, emphasize the same on its employees and staff and may only disclose the same without the prior written consent of the Employer or unless ordered to do so by an order of a Court of competent jurisdiction or is required by law to do so or unless such information is already in the public domain. For

the avoidance of doubt it is agreed that the provisions of this clause shall survivithe termination of this Agreement.

8. Payments

The Employer hereby covenants to pay the Contractor in consideration of the execution and completion of the Works- CONSTRUCTION OF KABULA MARKET MORDEN TOILETS IN KABULA WARD as set out in Tender Negotiation No. 788783-2019/2020 located in KABULA in Bungoma County and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the Contract at the times and in the manner prescribed by the Contract as per the application of payment made by the contractor in relation to the work performed through issuance of certificate by the project manager.

9. Term

10. Project Administration

The Client designates Project Resident Engineer in the office of Public Works as the Project Coordinator for purposes of this Agreement. The Project Coordinator will be responsible for the coordination of activities under this Agreement, acceptance and approval of any reports from the Contractor and of other deliverables by the Client and for receiving and approving invoices for payment. The Contractor shall liaise with the Project Coordinator to ensure that the scope of the work is clearly defined, the set activities are properly implemented and that the desired deliverables are achieved.

15. Assignment

The Contractor may subcontract with the approval of the project Manager, but may NOT assign this Contract or sub-contract or any portion of it without the Employer's prior written consent. Subcontracting shall Not alter the contractor's obligations.

16. Waiver

Subject to applicable law, no delay or failure by either party to exercise any of its powers, rights or remedies under this Agreement will operate as a waiver of them nor will any single or partial exercise of any such powers, rights or remedies preclude any other or further exercise of them. For any waiver, to be effective, the same must be in writing.

III. Entire Agreement and Variation

This Agreement contains the full and complete understanding between the parties and supersedes all prior arrangements and understandings whether written or oral appertaining to the subject matter of this Agreement and may not be varied except by an agreement in writing signed by the parties to this Agreement.

Severability

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If any provision of this agreement or provision thereof shall to any extent be illegal, invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of the Agreement shall not be affected thereby and solely each provision of this Agreement shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law. The parties shall negotiate in good faith the text of a provision, which shall replace the provision which is affected by such invalidity or alternatively, if it is deemed necessary not to replace such provision, the parties shall agree to restructure the transaction in such a way that the scope of the affected provision shall be maintained.

19. Indemnity

The Contractor agrees to indemnify The Employer from and against all losses, claims, damages, liabilities, proceedings and all related expenses, including court and legal fees, occasioned by any claim against The Employer arising out of dishonesty, failure, negligence or willful misconduct of the Contractor or its employees and/or servants and agents in relation to the works executed.

10. No Partnership or Agency or Employment Relationship

This Agreement shall in no way be interpreted as constituting a partnership, agency or employment relationship between the Employer and The Contractor or its employees and/or servants and agents.

21. Force Majeure

- a) Neither party shall be held liable for or in respect of any loss or damage or deemed to be in default for any delay or failure in performance of its obligations under this Agreement resulting from force majeure circumstances. Such circumstances shall include but not be limited to war, riots, usurped power, civil commotion, fire, industrial dispute, strikes, acts of God, acts of Government, acts of public enemy, boycott, embargo or any form of strike, explosions, failure of communications system, default of carrier or any cause or other circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the parties.
- b) The party pleading force majeure shall immediately notify the other party of the circumstances constituting the same and of the obligations that are affected and will take every reasonable measure to minimize the delays or inconvenience arising there from.
- c) If the force majeure circumstances persist for more than Fourteen (14) days after the initial notification by the party pleading force majeure, either party may serve the other party with seven (7) days' notice of termination.

22. <u>Dispute Resolution</u>

In case any dispute or difference arises between the Employer or the Project Manager on his behalf and the Contractor, either during the progress or after the completion or termination of the works with respect to this Agreement, the parties shall make good faith efforts to resolve the dispute through negotiations between them. Any dispute arising out of the Agreement which cannot be amicably settled between the parties shall within seven (7) days from the date the dispute is notified be referred by either party to arbitration for the final decision of an Arbitrator to be agreed between the parties. Failing agreement on the appointment of an Arbitrator within fourteen (14) days from the date of

Intilitate of Arbitrators, Kenya Branch, on the request of the party applying for arbitration pursuant to and in accordance with the Arbitration Act of 1995 or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof.

Applicable Law and Compliance with the Law

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- The Contract shall be governed by the Laws of Kenya and the language of the Contract shall be English Language.
- The Contractor shall ensure that it complies with all the laws and regulations in particular those that relate to execution and completion of the Works and the remedying of defects therein and shall, in respect of all persons employed by it anywhere for purposes of this Agreement observe and fulfill the conditions stipulated by the relevant laws of Kenya.
