1. The implementation status of the Lawrence Sifuna task force report on Bungoma County land with emphasis on:
 - a) The details of parcels of land that were grabbed and encroached by individuals and groups;
 - b) Action taken by the County Government to repossess the encroached and grabbed pieces of land;
2. The list of all the identified land parcels in the County;
3. The registration status of all the parcels of land clearly indicating those with title deeds, those in the process of being acquired and the extent of acquisition and those not initiated;
4. The list of all the parcels yet to be utilized with reasons for

non-utilization;

5. An elaborate explanation on the plans of the County Government for un-utilized pieces of land;
