8. **MOTION ON APPROVAL OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONDITIONAL ALLOCATION AGREEMENT**

**Pursuant to Standing Order No. 58, I beg to move the following motion;**

**AWARE** that Articles 189 and 190 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, provides for the cooperation between national and county governments and support for county governments respectively; **UNDERSTANDING** that Intergovernmental Relations Act No. 2 of 2012, in particular, section 4 establishes the principles of intergovernmental relations;

**RECOGNIZING THAT** the efforts of the Council of Governors to have a collaborative approach to development through partnering with the national government;

**AWARE THAT** the Council of Governors proposed and through a standardized format drafted a Model Intergovernmental Conditional Allocations Transfer Agreement between the Counties and National Government indicating the mode in which funds for various programs will be sourced and released from the National Government to operationalize activities in the respective County Governments in the current financial year 2023/24 and for connected purposes.

**Further aware** of the 14 days' timeline provided for consideration and approval by the County Assemblies since the receipt of the Agreement are almost lapsing.

**I NOW MOVE AND PROPOSE**, that this County Assembly resolves to adopt and approve the Intergovernmental Conditional Allocation Agreement to enable the County Government of Bungoma access the additional funding from the National Government
