- b) Compliance with legal and procedural requirements by ensuring that the composition of the committees complies with all legal, procedural and constitutional requirements

METHODOLOGY

The Selection Committee used multi step method to ensure effective and fair placement of members to committees through coalitional consultations.

SCRUTINY OF COMMITTEES' MEMBERSHIP

The Committee on Selection pursuant to its mandate scrutinized the Committees' membership to address concerns as raised by the respective coalitions. This was done through a mapping and matching process where preferences, diversity and representation were considered that led to a consensus building.
