**10. MOTION: ALTERATION OF THE HOUSE CALENDAR AND
 ADJOURNMENT**

(Leader of the Majority Party)

AWARE THAT, the House was originally scheduled to proceed on a short recess from Friday, 10th July 2026 to Monday, 20th July 2026, and resume regular sittings on Tuesday, 21st July 2026;

COGNIZANT THAT, this House has previously forfeited both its long recess and the short recess for the months of March Friday 20th – Monday 30th and May 2026 from Friday 1st – Monday 25th , having continuously executed its legislative mandate non-stop without a break;

RECOGNIZING THAT, like any other institutional body, this House and its Members require adequate time to refresh and rejuvenate in order to effectively sustain their constitutional duties;

NOTING the pressing need to allow Honorable Members dedicated time to attend to critical ward-level engagements and other pertinent grassroots matters;

FURTHER NOTING that during this altered recess period, there shall be a complete cessation of both Plenary and Committee work to ensure undivided focus on ward-level engagements and grassroots activities;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 31 (4) of the County Assembly of Bungoma, this House **RESOLVES** to alter its calendar by pulling the recess backward, to adjourn its regular sittings and proceed on a short recess from **Friday, 3rd July 2026 to Monday, 13th July 2026**, and resume its regular sittings on **Tuesday, 14th July 2026 at 2:30 p.m.**
