10. **MOTION - APPROVAL OF NOMINATION OF MEMBERS TO SERVE IN COMMITTEES**

(Leader of the Majority Party)

THAT, Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order No. 177(3), this House **APPROVES** the nomination and appointment of Members to serve in Select Committees as follows:

1. Hon. Polycarp Kimeta is appointed as a Member to the Sectoral Committee on Finance and Economic Planning; and the Sectoral Committee on Trade, Energy and Industrialization.
2. Hon. Henry Nyongesa, is appointed as a Member to the Sectoral Committee on Tourism, Environment and Natural Resources *in place of* Hon. Martin Chemorion, who is hereby discharged; Powers and Privileges *in place of* Hon. Orize Kundu, who is hereby discharged; and the Sectoral Committee on Youth Affairs and Sports *in place of* Hon. Abraham Obama, who is hereby discharged.

11. **MOTION – ALTERATION OF THE CALENDAR AND ADJOURNMENT**

(Leader of the Majority Party)

THAT, pursuant to the provisions of the Standing Order 31 (4) of the County Assembly of Bungoma, this House resolves to alter the Calendar as adopted, with respect to the Long Recess of the House.

AWARE THAT, the Calendar of the County Assembly of Bungoma as currently adopted provides for the House to proceed on Long Recess from Friday, 28th August 2026 to Monday, 21st September 2026;

COGNIZANT THAT, this August is a period during which a significant number of communities within Bungoma County observe the cultural rite of circumcision, an important and time-bound cultural season;

FURTHER AWARE THAT, it is within the mandate of this House to alter its own Calendar as circumstances necessitate, provided such alteration does not prejudice the constitutional and statutory timelines within which the Assembly is required to transact its business;

NOW THEREFORE, this House resolves as follows:

1. **THAT**, the Calendar of the County Assembly of Bungoma be and is hereby altered such that the Long Recess of the House is brought forward and shall run from **Friday, 31st July, 2026 to Monday 31st August, 2026**;
2. **THAT**, the period originally designated as the Long Recess in the Calendar, being **Friday 28th August, 2026 to Monday 21st September, 2026**, be and is hereby converted into ordinary sitting days of the House;
3. **THAT**, the House shall resume regular and uninterrupted sittings on **Tuesday, 1st September, 2026 at 2:30 p.m.**, and shall thereafter sit as scheduled without a break through the period previously set aside as the Long Recess;
4. **THAT**, all Committee schedules, and any other House programmes be realigned to conform to this revised Calendar.
